Spacious one- and three-bedroom suites offer comfortable apartment-style accommodations and a welcoming ambiance in every season. Know Before You Arrive

Complimentary parking is limited to one car per one-bedroom, two for a three-bedroom. Additional parking may be available for \$10 per day and is subject to availability. Single axel trailers must remain attached to vehicle and must not exceed 7,000 GVW. A daily charge of \$25 applies to trailers. All vehicles must be registered with the front desk. Mail/package policies have been updated and we now charge a fee of \$5 per letter and \$20 fee per incoming package. Sorry, we will not hold items more than 3 days prior to arrival.

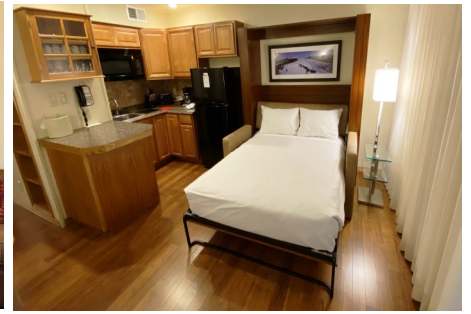
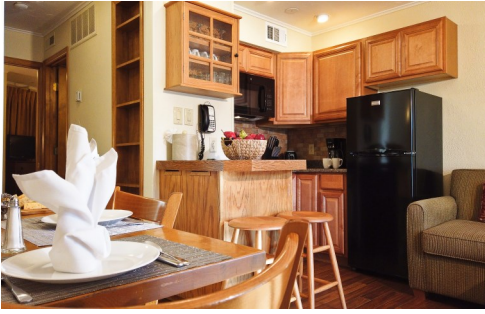

Room Types

One-Bedroom Suites

Enjoy 421 sq. ft. of space to relax, along with a triple-sheeted queen bed, a pull-down murphy sleeper sofa, seasonal wood-burning fireplace, private bathroom, furnished balcony and convenient kitchenette



Three-Bedroom Suites

The Three-Bedroom Suites average 840 sq. feet and add two more bedrooms to our one-bedroom suites. Each room offers a queen bed and a private bathroom. The living room has a full sized, pullout sofa bed and countertop style dinning table.



All suites offer fully equipped kitchenettes and furnished balconies. Relax on plush furnishings and watch one of two flat-screen televisions with free movie access. Free high-speed Wi-Fi keeps you connected while air conditioning units in the summer and cozy wood-burning fireplaces in the winter ensure your absolute comfort year-round.

Making Reservations for Your Owner Week

Owners can book their contract week up to 360 days prior to arrival. This can be done by calling the reservations office or on the owners' website. External exchange trading power is affected by how far in advance your week is deposited. It is recommended to reserve and bank as soon as possible to receive the maximum value. Weeks may be booked with Friday or Saturday arrivals (Friday arrivals subject to availability). Weeks 51 and 52 are fixed week ownership and these owners own a specific unit and fixed week.



Making Reservations Out of the Season You Own



The **Internal Exchange program** was developed to provide more flexibility and value for owners. This program allows an owner to visit The Christie Lodge during a different season, and at a significantly discounted rate versus exchanging through an external company. This is a great way to experience all of the wonderful seasons in the Vail Valley and a perfect solution to postponing your week if you are unable to come during your designated time-frame! Internal exchanges are valid for up to two- years from the deposit date and can only be booked or waitlisted over the phone. Our Reservation team will be happy to assist you with depositing your week! A low \$89 fee applies when we confirm your new week.

Gifting or Renting your Owner Week

Weeks may be gifted or shared to friends and family. To gift a week, please notify our reservations team and they will add your guest(s) to the reservation. Our association allows you to rent your unit by yourself as long as you are not renting to multiple renters in the same week and you are following the Town of Avon's Municipal Code that limits, regulates and taxes short-term rentals. The Town of Avon expects all owners who short-term rent their unit obtain a business license and pay taxes in order to be a legal short-term rental within the Town of Avon. Each owner must have their own separate license. Please comply with the town's licensing requirements or discontinue the short-term rental and advertising of your unit. The process to become licensed and comply with the Town's regulations by clicking the link below. You may also call the Town of Avon at 888-751-1911. If you are not compliant by January 1, 2019, The Town of Avon will refer this matter to the Avon Municipal Court for prosecution under Avon Municipal Code 5.04.130. Successful prosecutions can result in fines of up to \$2,650 plus costs, damages, and expenses pursuant to Avon Municipal Code 1.09.030.

Bonus Nights and Bonus Weeks

Excess hotel inventory may be available to owners at highly discounted rates and is subject to availability. If bonus nights are not available, owners are able to receive discounts from 15% to 25% depending on the length of stay.

- * **Bonus nights** must be reserved by the owner on the deed 30 days or less prior to arrival and may only be used by Immediate family: mother, father, sons, daughters, or spouse. Extended bonus nights can be available to grandchildren, brothers and sisters. Owners may book up to 12 bonus nights per calendar year for each contract they own and stays must total at least two-nights in the same unit. Since week 51 and 52 are fixed ownership weeks, they are not available for bonus night bookings.
- * **Bonus weeks** may be booked up to 360 days prior to arrival and are limited to one-week per year for each owned week and can only be used for Immediate and Extended family. Full payment is required at the time of reservation and the week is non-refundable.

Upgrades

One-Bedroom owners may have the option to upgrade their booked week to a Three-Bedroom Suite. Upgrades are subject to availability and can only be booked 45 days or less of requested arrival date. Upgrade rates are \$200/night and a three-night minimum is required. Upgrades are non-refundable and payment is due at the time of the reservation.
